Young Talents - mentoring programme for students. Join us!

Young Talents is a mentoring and networking programme for international students organized by Kids Kino Industry. [Kids Kino Industry](#) is an international co-production forum focused on audiovisual content for kids and youth. The aim of the Young Talents programme is to support young talents in entering the international market, share the know-how and match them with right decision makers and professionals. We strongly believe in the new and emerging talents that are creating the future of the industry and that's why the special spotlight on young talents at the KKI is given.

We are looking for students from film schools who are interested in animation, live-action or documentary films for young audiences. For now we have confirmed partners from the Czech Republic, Poland and Germany. During 3 days, about 6 students from different countries will participate in lectures, workshops, consultations and presentations of projects for young audiences accompanying the Kids Kino Industry co-production forum. They will experience what international markets and events look like for the film and TV industry. They will attend a dedicated session that will prepare them on how to talk to big companies to encourage them to invest in the project they are working on.

We are looking for partners to join us and nominate their students. One partner can send from 1 to maximum 2 students to KKI 2023.

For whom?

For students of film schools interested in kids content, animation and in particular in creating films and series for young audiences.

What can students gain?

- They will learn how to navigate international co-production markets.
- They will gain inspiration and exchange knowledge and experiences with students from other countries and representatives of the international film industry.
- They will gain the chance to learn about and present their ideas for films and series in front of the most important players in the film market (in previous years, the forum has hosted representatives from Disney, Netflix, Warner Bros. Discovery, Viaplay Group).

What can the School gain?

- Promotion of the School and its students at one of the biggest co-production forums devoted entirely to the production of films and series for young audiences in Europe.
- Increasing the offer for students with a mentoring and networking programme.
- Gain new partners and future potential employers for their students - the forum is attended by many producers and heads of animation studios who are looking for animation and graphic design students and graduates.

Participation fee:

350 EUR per participant. The fee covers: accommodation, board (breakfast, lunch) + accreditation to Kids Kino Industry and Kids Kino IFF. Travel is arranged by the participant.

Timeline:

14th of April - confirmation of partnership + contract signature

20 th of May - confirmation of participants

early June - announcement of the participants from each country
